1 Annual contributions for human and veterinary medicinal products

The annual contribution for medicinal products for human and veterinary use with indications (all dispensing categories) consists of two components: a turnover-based share and a volume-based share. It serves to compensate Refdata Services GmbH for the services described in Appendix 2.

1.1 Turnover-based contribution

Annual turnover is defined as the turnover generated **in Switzerland** by the company with human and/or veterinary medicinal products (HAM/TAM) in all dispensing categories.

1.2 Volume-based contribution

The volume-based contribution is calculated based on the number of items with a GTIN and one of the following trade statuses in SIMIS, Article module, on the reference date of 31 December:

- "In trade since, dd.mm.yyyy"
- "out of trade until, dd.mm.yyyy"
- "In trade until, dd.mm.yyyy"

Items with these trade statuses are published in the item refdatabase. The number of items is determined by RDS. Changes during the year are neither debited nor credited.

2 Annual fees for non-pharmaceutical items

Non-pharmaceutical items are defined as medicinal products without indication, medical devices and other healthcare products. The following annual fees for non-pharmaceutical items apply only in conjunction with a valid contract for the digital management and publication of specialist and patient information/package inserts for human and veterinary medicinal products via the platform www.simisinfo.ch.

- "in trade since, dd.mm.yyyy"
- "out of trade until dd.mm.yyyy"
- "On sale until, dd.mm.yyyy"

Articles with this trade status are published in the article refdatabase. The number of articles is determined by RDS. Changes during the year are neither charged nor credited.

3 Service catalogue for companies without a contract

Without a valid contract or if the contract has been terminated, the following fees will be charged for services related to the management of human or veterinary drug information:

- Changes to existing FI, PI or PB (per text and language):	CHF 500

4 Special provisions for GTINs with the prefix "7680"

4.1 General

The GS1 number range "7680XXXXXYYP" is licensed by Refdata and is used to assign GTINs (Global Trade Item Numbers) for the unique identification of medicinal products authorised by Swissmedic with indications across all dispensing categories. XXXXX refers to the 5-digit Swissmedic authorisation number and YYY refers to the 3-digit Swissmedic packaging code.

The licence entails the following obligations for Refdata:

- Payment of an annual licence fee to GS1 Switzerland.
- Referencing and publication of the assigned GTINs.

4.2 Terminated contract

Without a valid contract or if the contract is terminated, the company loses the right to continue using the GTINs licensed by Refdata with the prefix 7680. After the termination period of 3 months, the company must use newly produced packages with a GTIN from the company's own GS1 number range. **The company has 3 years to sell the packages produced before the termination date.**

4.3 Misuse

Misuse of the prefix "7680" includes, in particular, the following cases:

- The company has no contract with Refdata and uses the prefix "7680" to identify items.
- The company continues to use the prefix "7680" after the termination date to identify newly produced packages.
- The company uses the prefix "7680" after the termination date to identify packages newly approved by Swissmedic.
- The company uses identification numbers that have not been assigned to it to identify medicinal products, i.e. medicinal products without a 5-digit authorisation number and a 3-digit package code.

If Refdata determines that a company is misusing the prefix "7680", it will notify the company in writing and request a statement. The company is fully liable for any damage incurred by Refdata. In addition to the above measures, Refdata may demand a contractual penalty of CHF 50,000 per incident from the company at fault. The misuse of the GS1 system in general and of the prefix "7680" in particular constitutes document forgery within the meaning of Art. 251 of the Swiss Criminal Code and will be reported to the competent law enforcement authorities if the requirements for doing so are met.
